

YEG Reconnect 6-Month Report Back

Resource Connect is a biennial event that brings together non-profit agencies and service providers in Edmonton & Area to share their programs and services. One primary purpose is to foster collaboration and networking among non-profit organizations. Agencies can build relationships and identify opportunities for joint projects or initiatives to better serve the community. The event allows the sharing of resources, best practices, innovative approaches and lessons learned.

A total of 630 guests attended Resource Connect 2022, including local politicians. Ninety-one agencies from various sectors participated, sharing resources around issues such as family well-being, senior support, community safety, newcomer support and housing.

Surveys conducted at the event contributed to a report highlighting the gaps and opportunities agencies see in being able to collaborate with one another. 75 Agencies answered the surveys, which informed a new initiative on how to create practical ways for agencies to collaborate: YEG Reconnect is an ongoing, year-round initiative built on the success of Resource Connect. Over the first six months of Reconnect, a variety of organizations have successfully found new connections and raised awareness of their services.

EVENTS

During Resource Connect 2022, 66 agencies answered the question "How might we create more opportunities for exhibitor agencies to interact and explore common issues throughout the year?"



70% of survey respondents expressed a desire for more frequent networking events throughout the year. In order to help agencies build new service pathways through collaboration, The YEG Reconnect initiative has engaged the community with three different events:

AN EVENING OF PRESENTATIONS

"An Evening of Presentations" is a monthly event where 3 prominent community agencies are given 30 minutes to speak of their organization's story and services, followed by a short Q&A session. After the presentations, guests have dedicated networking time to form new collaborations. The event is targeted at non-profit workers at all levels. However, free tickets are made available to all members of Edmonton's diverse communities.

NETWORK GATHERINGS

YEG Reconnect Quarterly Gatherings are exclusive, invite-only virtual events that occur three times per year. These events are targeted at management staff, board members, and politicians in order to voice concerns and find new ways to bridge service gaps among those with increased influence in the community.

In each event, two presenters deliver concise presentations on subjects such as locating grants, volunteers, and additional resources. Subsequently, participants are furnished with discussion prompts, such as 'What are the organizational gaps you've identified? What gaps exist within the community?' Afterward, attendees convene in breakout sessions, where they collaboratively explore these topics and exchange insights. Noteworthy issues raised include challenges in coordinating comprehensive wrap-around care for clients and competing for talent and resources.

The desired outcomes for the upcoming Teatime Social Connection gathering with non-profit agency partners and stakeholders revolves around building stronger partnerships, sharing knowledge and resources, and ultimately improving the collective impact of these organizations on the community. Both REACH staff and workers at partner agencies will be invited. This will create familiarity between all community members with the myriad services and initiatives each support as a part of their daily work.

Knowledgeable speakers from specific agencies, as well as with specific, verified life experience, will be invited to organically facilitate conversations about important topics affecting community safety. In the upcoming inaugural event, the topic of Human Trafficking will be at the forefront in order to promote the important work of Alberta's new Alberta Office to Combat Trafficking in Persons.

RESOURCE CONNECT 2024

In Edmonton, Resource Connect stands as the premier networking event within the non-profit sector. Following the resounding success of the 2022 event, organizers are poised for the 2024 Resource Connect to surpass all previous iterations. An invitation will extend to over two hundred organizations, affording them the opportunity to showcase their services. Preparations have commenced a full 15 months in advance, and a dedicated Resource Connect Planning Committee is in formation to ensure the event unfolds seamlessly.

The forthcoming event reaffirms REACH's unwavering commitment to highlighting Indigenous perspectives. It will establish a central physical platform for Indigenous practices and Indigenous-led agencies, underscoring the importance of Indigenous voices within the non-profit community









This event serves as a platform for:

Evaluation and Impact Assessment: Learn how to better measure and communicate the outcomes and effectiveness of their services

Celebrating Achievements: Platform to celebrate the achievements and milestones of non-profit agencies in Edmonton. Recognizing and honoring their contributions can boost morale and inspire continued dedication to their missions

Strengthening the Non-Profit Sector: The overarching purpose is to strengthen the non-profit sector in Edmonton. By facilitating collaboration, resource-sharing, and learning opportunities, the event aims to enhance the collective ability of these agencies to address community needs effectively

WEBSITE LAUNCH



At Resource Connect 2022, a total of 62 agencies participated in addressing the query regarding the enhancement of communication channels among exhibitor agencies to facilitate the sharing of innovations and resources.

Impressively, 68% of respondents advocated for the creation of a centralized and interactive portal or platform, envisioned as a dynamic avenue for agencies to exchange information and stay abreast of available resources within the city. These innovative solutions encompassed the development of a website, active engagement through social media platforms, and periodic newsletters distributed by REACH. The forthcoming YEG Reconnect website stands as a promising response to these evolving communication requirements.

FEATURES

Forum and Chat

The inclusion of forum and chat functions directly addresses the requirements identified by agencies during Resource Connect 2022. The website provides an interactive platform that engages and empowers community members to share resources, seek answers to queries, and explore innovative modes of organization. Additionally, the website features a community gallery, allowing users to share event photos and other relevant content, fostering a sense of community engagement and connection.




Upcoming Events
